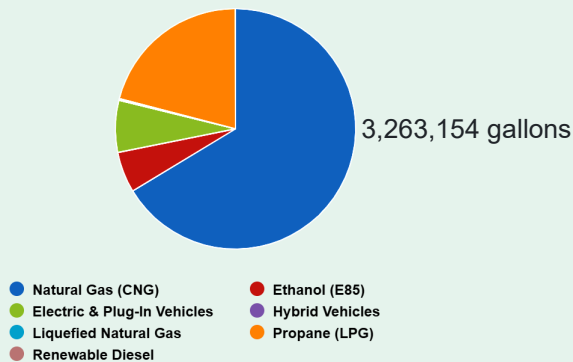

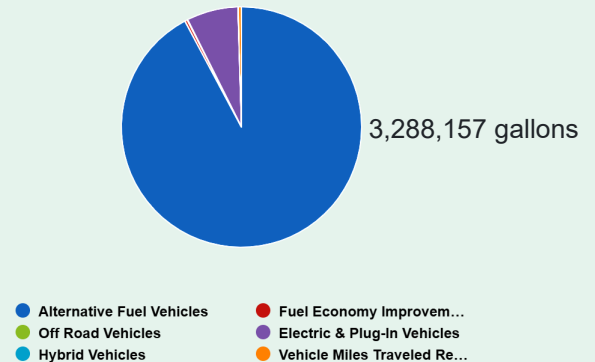

Annual Petroleum Savings by Alternative Fuel Vehicle Project Type



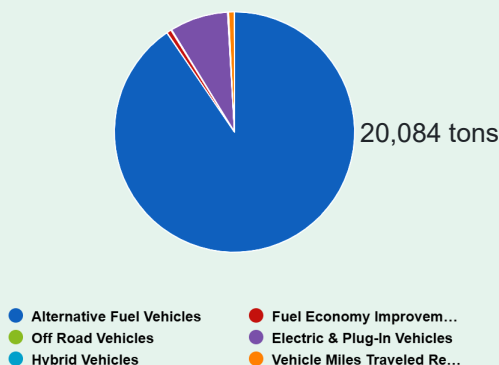

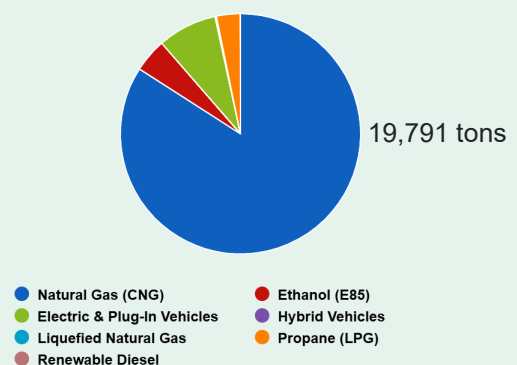
